

Dear all

Start 1330 hrs. Finish 1700hrs.

Our walk starts from Moelfre village sea life centre (parking is available for about 20 cars) and finishes at the village Pentraeth at the Panton Arms pub.

Grade of walk is easy but caution must be adhered to as we will be passing water courses, steep drops feet away from the path and the odd gentle slope. Of course this can all be overcome with some simple forethought. Wet weather gear, good boots or ankle supporting walk shoes are essential. To this add a backpack with sun cream, hat and water also make our walk a treat add the odd jam butty!

The duration should be approximately 4 hours at a steady pace. From time to time there will be four step offs where anyone can say farewell, dependent upon their stamina.

We walk down from the sea life centre through some of the greatest Carboniferous Limestone shoreline the world can offer. We trail down time to time stepping into golden sandy beaches like Benllech.

A camera and binoculars make sea life watching more eventful. This coupled with late spring fauna and fantastic vistas. Make for some powerful prayers linking ourselves to the rest of our group in prayer along the Ynys Mon/ Anglesey coast.
